

Weeds are problematic in our landscapes due to the fact they are aesthetically unpleasing and compete with desirable plants for water, nutrients and sunlight. This is a quick guide to help identify and control many of the most common weeds found throughout the state. While this is not a complete guide that covers all weeds, it addresses the major weeds that cause problems in South Carolina landscapes.

#### **Types of weeds**

Most weeds fall into one of two categories either annual or perennial. Annual weeds complete their life cycle in one season. At the end of the growing season annual weeds produce seed to ensure future weed populations. Because most annual weeds start from seed, pre-emergent herbicides are usually the best means of controlling them by inhibiting their germination.

There are both cool-season and warm-season annual weeds. Cool-season weeds begin to germinate when soil temperatures fall below 55 degrees F (Fall) and complete their life cycle in the spring time when warmer weather begins. Warm-season annual weeds begin to germinate when soil temperatures rise above 55 degrees F (Spring) and complete their life cycle when cool weather begins.

Perennial weeds once established in the landscape will survive for many growing seasons. These types of weeds can reproduce through several different means including seed and underground structures. The most effective way to deal with perennial weeds is through the use of post-emergent herbicides.

The two other categories that weeds fall under are broadleaf and grassy. Broadleaf weeds come in many shapes and sizes with various patterns to their leaves. Just as the name implies, broadleaf weeds are generally more wide than long. Grassy weeds tend to be narrower and longer, similar to the grass in your lawn. It is important for you to make the distinction between these two classifications, in order to select the proper herbicide for their control. As a general rule, most grassy weed herbicides will not control broadleaf weeds and vice versa.

## Carolina Geranium (Geranium carolinianum) Type: Broadleaf Life cycle: Annual (Cool season)







**Description:** Somewhat upright winter annual with deeply lobed leaves. Stems greenish to pinkish red and hairy. Flowers have five petals and are pink to purplish in color. Reproduces by seed.

## Chamberbitter (Phyllanthus urinaria)

Type: Broadleaf Life cycle: Annual (Warm season)







**Description:** Upright summer annual with stems that are angled or grooved. Leaves contain seeds on underneath side and have smooth margins. Leaf shape is oblong and thin. Chamberbitter develops a deep tap root when mature.

Carpetweed (Mollugo verticillata) Type: Broadleaf Life cycle: Annual (Warm season)







**Description:** Warm season annual broadleaf weed with prostrate growth. Contains numerous smooth, branched stems with leaves arranged in whorls. Leaves are spoon shaped with five to six at each node. Produces small white flowers with with five petals. Reproduces from seed.

## **Florida Pusley**

(Richardia scabra)

**Description:** Warm season annual broadleaf weed with oval, opposite thick leaves. Stems are branched and hairy that grow in a prostrate manner. Produces tubular white flowers at the end of branches. Reproduces by seed.

## Common Lespedeza (Lespedeza striata) Type: Broadleaf Life cycle: Annual (Warm season)







**Description:** Summer annual weed with wiry, prostrate growth. Develops a woody tap root as it matures during summer months. Leaves have a prominent mid-rib with veins that branch at 45 degree angles. Leaves are oval in shape and contain small flowers that are pink to purplish. Reproduces from seed.

**Description:** Annual broadleaf weed that grows prostrate. Leaves are opposite with reddish spot usually present in the middle. Stems are reddish in color and contain milky sap. Reproduces from seed annually.

# **Shiny Cudweed**

Life cycle: Annual or Biennial







**Description:** Broadleaf weed with rosette of basal leaves. Leaf color bright and shiny on upper surface. Lower surface of leaves is hairy and grayish, white in color. Reproduces by seed. Often found in dry, sandy conditions.

**Description:** Annual broadleaf weed with upright growth in a clump. Produces white flowers at end of stems with four petals. Produces an elongated seed pod at the end of stems. Reproduces by seed.

**Description:** Broadleaf winter annual that grows low to the ground. Contains opposite leaves with deeply cut lobes. Very small flowers that are inconspicuous. Fruit has SHARP spines that can cause injury when touched. Reproduces from seed.

**Description:** Broadleaf annual with opposite leaves. Underside of leaves have pronounced veins. Leaf edges are toothed, but blunt on the ends. Overall appearance is greenish to purplish in color. Stems are four sided. Flowers are reddish to purple in color. Reproduces by seed.





## Dandelion (Taraxacum officinale) Type: Broadleaf Life Cycle: Perennial







**Description:** Perennial broadleaf weed with deep taproot. Clump type growth. Leaves with shallow to deeply cut margins. Produces single yellow flowers on stalk that contains "milky" juice when broken.

## Florida Betony (Stachys floridana)

Type: Broadleaf Life cycle: Perennial



**Description:** Perennial broadleaf weed with opposite lance-shaped leaves on square stems. Leaves on long stalks. Produces whitish to purplish flowers with purple spots. Contains underground tubers that resemble rattles of a rattlesnake, thus is sometimes referred to as rattlesnake weed.

# **Dogfennel** (*Eupatorium capillifolium*) Type: Broadleaf Life Cycle: Perennial (Warm Season Growth)







**Description:** Broadleaf perennial weed with tall upright growth. Leaves are thin, deeply cut and aromatic when crushed. Stems are hairy and woody on lower sections. Reproduces from seed and regrowth from woody base.

#### **Description:**

Upright perennial broadleaf weed with round leaves that are scalloped along the edges. Petiole attaches in the center of the leaf to form an "umbrella like" appearance. Prefers moist conditions and forms mats in areas of high population. Reproduces through seed, underground runners, and tubers.

**Description:** Perennial broadleaf weed with thick, fleshy leaves on hairy stems. Leaves are opposite. Grows in a spreading type fashion. Produces white flowers that grow along the stem. Prefers moist sites. Reproduces from seed, roots, and stem fragments.

**Description:** Perennial weed with slender, hollow leaves that grow upright. Grows during cooler months of the year. Similar to Wild Garlic in appearance. Contains a central underground bulb with a fibrous coat. Does not contain offset bulblets like Wild Garlic.


